Cool Facts:

- The Holy Spirit manifesting produces something seen & heard
[Acts 2:32-33 NASB](#) "This Jesus God raised up again, to which we are all witnesses. (33) "Therefore having been exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He has poured forth this **which you both see and hear**.
- Tongues are a sign of a believer
[Mark 16:17 NASB](#) "These signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak with new tongues;
- 2 Different Giftings: Public Gift & Prayer Language
- Manifestation of the Holy Spirit
[1 Corinthians 12:7-11 KJV](#) (7) But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. (8) For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; (9) To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; (10) To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another *divers* kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: (11) But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.
- Tongues plays a role in the local church
[1 Corinthians 12:28 NASB](#) (28) And God has appointed in the church, first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, *various* kinds of tongues.

Commands:

- Be Filled
Ephesians 5:18-21 NASB And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit, (19) speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord; (20) always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God, even the Father; (21) and be subject to one another in the fear of Christ.
- Don't Forbid Tongues
1 Corinthians 14:39 NASB (39) Therefore, my brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak in tongues.
- Pray at all times in the Spirit
Ephesians 6:18 NASB With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints,
- Pray with this in view (in mind)
Ephesians 6:18 NASB With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints,
- All Tongues MUST operate through Love
1 Corinthians 13:1 NASB (1) If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.
- Desire/Covet Tongues & Interpretation
1 Corinthians 14:1 NASB (1) Pursue love, yet desire earnestly spiritual *gifts*, but especially that you may prophesy.

Benefits of Tongues:

- Life Flows from Baptism of the Holy Spirit
John 7:37-39 KJV In the last day, that great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, **If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. (38) He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (39)** (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet *given*; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)
- Builds You Up! **Jude 1:20 NASB** But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit,

- Helps Our Weaknesses
Romans 8:26-28 NASB In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for *us* with groanings too deep for words; (27) and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints according to *the will of God*. (28) And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to *His* purpose.
- Perfect Prayers (for ourselves & others)
Ephesians 6:18-20 NASB With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints, (19) and *pray* on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel, (20) for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in *proclaiming* it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.
- Fans the Flames of God's Fire & BOLDNESS in You
2 Timothy 1:6-7 NASB For this reason I remind you to kindle afresh the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands. (7) For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline.
- Gives Thanks Well
1 Corinthians 14:16-17 NASB (16) Otherwise if you bless in the spirit *only*, how will the one who fills the place of the ungifted say the "Amen" at your giving of thanks, since he does not know what you are saying? (17) For you are giving thanks well enough...
Colossians 3:16 NASB Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

Public Gift vs. Prayer Language 1 Corinthians 14

- Public Needs Interpretation
 Interpretation can be: Words, Revelation, Knowledge, Prophecy or Teaching
- Prayer Language Doesn't Need Interpretation: Groanings Too Deep for Words (or interpretation)
- Prayer Language Speaks to God
- Public Speaks to men

- Prayer Language speaks mysteries
- Public speaks to edify people: builds up, encourages & comforts
- Prayer Language builds yourself up
- Public builds up the church
- Prayer Language can be had by all
- Public is a gift from the Holy Spirit to certain people
- Prayer Language is willed by you at anytime
- Public Gift is willed by the Holy Spirit then we obey
- Prayer Language can be worship & giving of thanks
- Public Gift can be given by 2 or 3 people.
(you can have more that 2 or 3 words given)

2 Chronicles 5:13-14 NASB (13) in unison when the trumpeters and the singers were to make themselves heard with one voice to praise and to glorify the LORD, and when they lifted up their voice accompanied by trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and when they praised the LORD *saying*, "He indeed is good for His lovingkindness is everlasting," then the house, the house of the LORD, was filled with a cloud, **(14)** so that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud, for the glory of the LORD filled the house of God.

Acts 2:1-17 NASB When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. **(2)** And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. **(3)** And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they rested **on each one** of them. **(4)** And they were **all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues**, as the Spirit was giving them utterance. **(5)** Now there were Jews living in Jerusalem, devout men from every nation under heaven. **(6)** And when this sound occurred, the crowd came together, and were bewildered because each one of them was hearing them speak in his own language. **(7)** They

were amazed and astonished, saying, "Why, are not all these who are speaking Galileans? (8) "And how is it that we each hear *them* in our own language to which we were born? (9) "Parthians and Medes and Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, (10) Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the districts of Libya around Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, (11) Cretans and Arabs--we hear them in our *own* tongues speaking of the mighty deeds of God." (12) And they all continued in amazement and great perplexity, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" (13) But others were mocking and saying, "They are full of sweet wine." (14) But Peter, taking his stand with the eleven, raised his voice and declared to them: "Men of Judea and all you who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you and give heed to my words. (15) "For these men are not drunk, as you suppose, for it is *only* the third hour of the day; (16) but this is what was spoken of through the prophet Joel: (17) 'AND IT SHALL BE IN THE LAST DAYS,' God says, 'THAT I WILL POUR FORTH OF MY SPIRIT ON ALL MANKIND; AND YOUR SONS AND YOUR DAUGHTERS SHALL PROPHECY, AND YOUR YOUNG MEN SHALL SEE VISIONS, AND YOUR OLD MEN SHALL DREAM DREAMS;

Acts 4:29-31 NASB "And now, Lord, take note of their threats, and grant that Your bond-servants may speak Your word with all confidence, (30) while You extend Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place through the name of Your holy servant Jesus." (31) And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and **they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak** the word of God with boldness.

Acts 8:12-18 NASB But when they believed Philip preaching the good news about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were being baptized, men and women alike. (13) Even Simon himself believed; and after being baptized, he continued on with Philip, and as he observed signs and great miracles taking place, he was constantly amazed. (14) Now when the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent them Peter and John, (15) who came down and prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit. (16) For He had not yet fallen upon any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. (17) Then they *began* laying their hands on them, and they were receiving the Holy Spirit. (18) Now when Simon **saw** that the Spirit was bestowed through the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money,

Acts 9:17-18 NASB So Ananias departed and entered the house, and after **laying his hands** on him said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the

road by which you were coming, has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit." (18) And immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and he regained his sight, and he got up and was baptized;

Acts 10:44-48 NASB While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who were listening to the message. (45) All the circumcised believers who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. (46) For **they were hearing them speaking with tongues and exalting God**. Then Peter answered, (47) "Surely no one can refuse the water for these to be baptized who have received the Holy Spirit just as we *did*, can he?" (48) And he ordered them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to stay on for a few days.

Acts 19:1-7 NASB It happened that while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul passed through the upper country and came to Ephesus, and found some disciples. (2) He said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" And they *said* to him, "No, we have not even heard whether there is a Holy Spirit." (3) And he said, "Into what then were you baptized?" And they said, "Into John's baptism." (4) Paul said, "John baptized with the baptism of repentance, telling the people to believe in Him who was coming after him, that is, in Jesus." (5) When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. (6) And **when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they began speaking with tongues and prophesying**. (7) There were in all about twelve men.
