LIFE GROUP TOPIC: The Holy & The Profane...

Ezekiel 44:23 NASB "Moreover, they [*the priests*] shall teach My people *the difference* between the **holy** and the **profane**, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.

Discussion Topic: What does HOLY mean?

Discussion Topic: What does PROFANE mean?

Biblical definitions:

Holy: Proper, whole, entire or perfect in a moral sense, set apart, consecrated

Profane: exposed; common, ordinary, un-holy(improper, unwholesome, unconsecrated, etc)

An example of mixing the Holy & Profane:

Revelation 3:15-16 NASB (15) 'I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot. (16) 'So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth.

Ezekiel 22:26 NASB "Her priests **have done violence to My law and have profaned My holy things**; they have made no distinction between the holy and the profane, and they have not taught the difference between the unclean and the clean; and they hide their eyes from My sabbaths, and **I am profaned among them.**

Mixing the Holy & Profane brings violence against the law of God.

God says when you mix the Holy & Profane that HE is profaned, or made common amongst them, or in their midst.
