



Isaiah 6:3-7 NASB: ³ And one called out to another and said,
“Holy, Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts,
The whole earth is full of His glory.”

⁴ And the foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him who called out, while the temple was filling with smoke. ⁵ Then I said,
“Woe is me, for I am ruined!

Because I am a man of unclean lips,
And I live among a people of unclean lips;
For my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.”

⁶ Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs. ⁷ He touched my mouth *with it* and said, “Behold, this has touched your lips; and your iniquity is taken away and your sin is forgiven.”

The same thing that happened to Isaiah can happen to us. God wants to take His burning and consuming fire and touch us *and* cleanse us from unholiness! Turn toward the Lord! Let the consuming and devouring fire do what it does!

Read **1 Kings 18:15-46**

We need to follow Elijah’s footsteps:

- We need to be willing to come and put our flesh on the altar.
- We need a conviction in our heart that puts us in a place where there’s no going back.
- We need to repair the altar of the Lord=the altar of our hearts.
- We need to place something precious on the altar that was repaired. (Elijah poured 1 week’s worth of water on the altar. It was the most precious thing He had. What is precious to our flesh?)

1 Kings 38-39 NASB: ³⁸ Then the fire of the LORD fell and consumed the burnt offering and the wood and the stones and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench. ³⁹ When all the people saw it, they fell on their faces; and they said, “The LORD, He is God; the LORD, He is God.”

The fire of God is proof to all humanity that the ***Lord is God!***

The fire of God consumes *everything* that stands in the way of the presence of God. We can't come and stand in the presence of God without the fire of God having done a work on us.

When we allow ourselves to be overcome by the fire of God, we:

1. Can stand in God's presence
2. Become a carrier of His fire, and
3. When we get near other people, they get caught on fire!

Through Jesus, we have access to the Holy Spirit, the overflowing, indwelling of the Holy Spirit!
We have access to be overflowed by the fire of God!

We need to prepare a place for the fire to come. That place is prepared by us saying, "I honor You. I humble myself to You. I put me on that altar."

Is your altar prepared? Are you ready to place yourself on the altar? If so, then NOW, ask Jesus to baptize you with the Holy Spirit AND fire!
