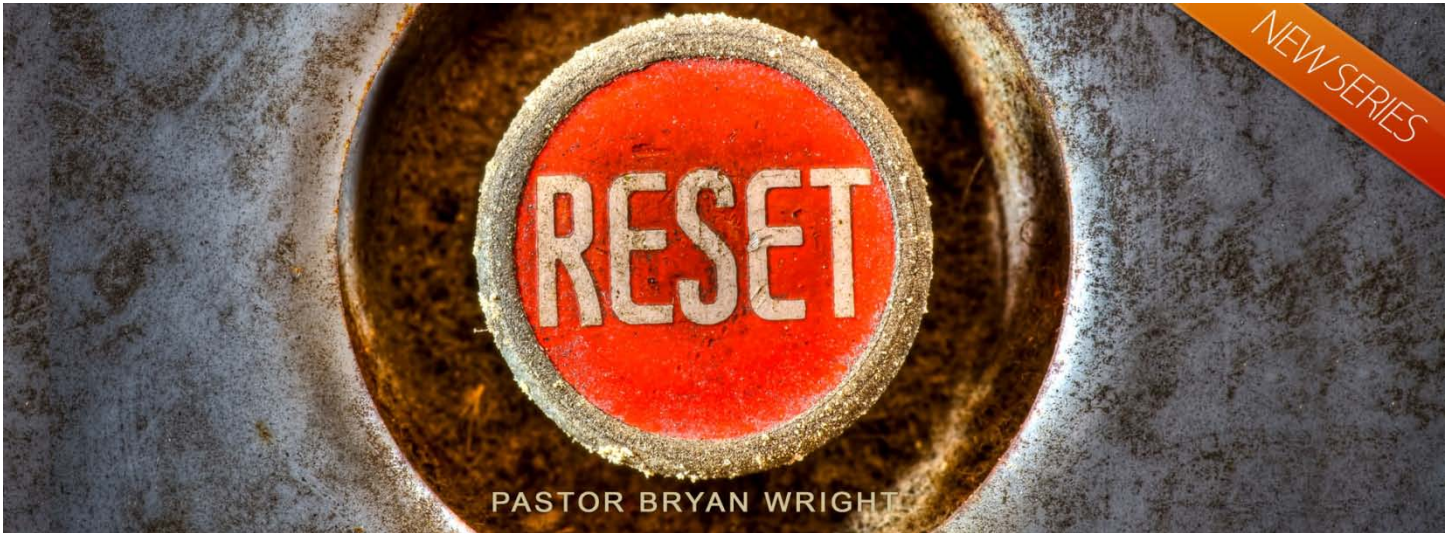

RESET is not really taught. It is caught.

What is RESET?

A RESET is going back to our first love of God before corruption set in.

A RESET sets us back to a continuous heavenly fellowship with our Father.

**A RESET is NOT feelings or warm & fuzzies.
It is unconditional giving, back & forth, between you & God.**

Revelation 2:1-5 NASB "To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: The

One who holds the seven stars in His right hand, the One who walks among the seven golden lampstands, says this: (2) 'I know your deeds and your **toil and perseverance**, and that you cannot tolerate evil men, and you put to the test those who call themselves apostles, and they are not, and you found them *to be* false; (3) and you have **perseverance and have endured** for My name's sake, and **have not grown weary**. (4) 'But I have *this* against you, that you have left your first love. (5) 'Therefore **remember from where** you have fallen, and **repent and do the deeds you did at first**; or else I am coming to you and will remove your lampstand out of its place--unless you repent.

Exodus 19:16-20 NASB So it came about on the third day, when it was morning, that there were thunder and lightning flashes and a thick cloud upon the mountain and a very loud trumpet sound, so that all the people who *were* in the camp trembled. (17) And Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet God, and they stood at the foot of the mountain. (18) Now Mount Sinai *was* all in smoke because the LORD descended upon it in fire; and its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain quaked violently. (19) When the sound of the trumpet grew louder and louder, Moses spoke and God answered him with thunder. (20) The LORD came down on Mount Sinai, to the top of the mountain; and the LORD called Moses to the top of the mountain, and Moses went up.

Exodus 20:19-21 NASB Then they said to Moses, "**Speak to us yourself and we will listen; but let not God speak to us, or we will die.**" (20) Moses said to the people, "**Do not be afraid; for God has come in order to test you, and in order that the fear of Him may remain with you, so that you may not sin.**" (21) So the people stood at a distance, while Moses approached the thick cloud where God *was*.

Exodus 34:28-30 NASB So he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did not eat bread or drink water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments. (29) It came about when Moses was coming down from Mount Sinai (and the two tablets of the testimony *were* in Moses' hand as he was coming down from the mountain), that Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone because of his speaking with Him. (30) So when Aaron and all the sons of Israel saw Moses, behold, the skin of his face shone, and they were afraid to come near him.

Exodus 34:33-35 NASB When Moses had finished speaking with them, he put a veil over his face. (34) But whenever Moses went in before the LORD to speak with Him, he would take off the veil until he came out; and whenever he came out and spoke to the sons of Israel what he had been commanded, (35) the sons of Israel would see the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face shone. So Moses would replace the veil over his face until he went in to speak with Him.

Matthew 27:50-54 NASB And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and yielded up His spirit. (51) And behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth shook and the rocks were split. (52) The tombs were opened, and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; (53) and coming out of the tombs after His resurrection they entered the holy city and appeared to many. (54) Now the centurion, and those who were with him keeping guard over Jesus, when they saw the earthquake and the things that were happening, became very frightened and said, "Truly this was the Son of God!"

**Our real & true relationship with God is meant to be personal.
You cannot RESET through someone else.**

You cannot have your own relationship through my faith or my revelations.

**Church is extremely important. IT IS a part of RESET.
BUT it is NOT a RESET relationship itself!**

2 Corinthians 3:12-18 NASB (12) Therefore having such a hope, we use great boldness in *our* speech, (13) and *are* not like Moses, *who* used to put a veil over his face so that the sons of Israel would not look intently at the end of what was fading away. (14) But their minds were hardened; for until this very day at the reading of the old covenant the same veil remains unlifted, because it is removed in Christ. (15) But to this day whenever Moses is read, a veil lies over their heart; (16) but whenever a person turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. (17) Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, *there* is liberty. (18) But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord,

the Spirit.

Are you ready to RESET with God?

- You are RESET right now,
- BUT if you continue walking like you did, you will just need another RESET before long.
- Let's start to LIVE a RESET LIFE!

What I want you to do:

1. Keep in mind all week that He is RIGHT THERE with you
2. Stop & Thank God for ANY good or perfect gift
3. When you go to bed tonight, tell Him goodnight
4. When you wake up in the morning, welcome Him again
