Esther 8:15 NASB Then Mordecai went out from the presence of the king in royal robes of blue and white, with a large crown of gold and a garment of fine linen and purple; and the city of Susa shouted and rejoiced.

Exodus 25:1-4, 8 NASB

- (1) Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,
- (2) "Tell the sons of Israel to raise a contribution for Me; from every man whose heart moves him you shall raise My contribution.
- (3) "This is the contribution which you are to raise from them: gold, silver and bronze,
- (4) blue, purple and scarlet *material*, fine linen, goat *hair*,
- (8) "Let them construct a sanctuary for Me, that I may dwell among them.

Blue can represent: heavenly power, rulership & government, royalty, commandment, judgment, completion

Numbers 15:37-40 NASB

- (37) The LORD also spoke to Moses, saying,
- (38) "Speak to the sons of Israel, and tell them that they shall make for themselves tassels on the corners[*FRINGE*] of their garments throughout their generations, and that they shall put on the tassel of each corner[*FRINGE*] a cord of blue.
- (39) "It shall be a tassel for you to look at and **remember all the commandments** of the LORD, so as to do them and **not follow after your own heart** and your own eyes, after which you played the harlot,
- (40) so that you may remember to do all My commandments and be holy to your God.

Exodus 26:1-11 NASB

- (1) "Moreover you shall make the tabernacle with ten curtains of fine twisted linen and blue and purple and scarlet *material*; you shall make them with cherubim, the work of a skillful workman.
- (2) "The length of each curtain shall be twenty-eight cubits, and the width of each curtain four cubits; all the curtains shall have the same

measurements.

- (3) "Five curtains shall be joined to one another, and *the other* five curtains *shall be* joined to one another.
- (4) "You shall make **loops of blue** on the edge of the outermost curtain in the *first* set, and likewise you shall make *them* on the edge of the curtain that is outermost in the second set.
- (5) "You shall make **fifty loops** in the one curtain, and you shall make fifty loops on the edge of the curtain that is in the second set; the loops shall be opposite each other.
- (6) "You shall make **fifty clasps of gold** [*glory of God & refinement of His Spirit*], and join the curtains to one another with the clasps so that the tabernacle will be a unit.
- (7) "Then you shall make curtains of goats' *hair* for a tent over the tabernacle; you shall make eleven curtains in all.
- (8) "The length of each curtain *shall be* thirty cubits, and the width of each curtain four cubits; the eleven curtains shall have the same measurements.
- (9) "You shall join five curtains by themselves and the *other* six curtains by themselves, and you shall double over the sixth curtain at the front of the tent.
- (10) "You shall make **fifty loops on the edge of the curtain** that is outermost in the *first* set, and fifty loops on the edge of the curtain *that is outermost in* the second set.
- (11) "You shall make **fifty clasps of bronze**, and you shall put the clasps into the loops and join the tent together so that it will be a unit.

Exodus 28:28-29 NASB "They shall bind the breastpiece by its rings to the rings of the ephod with a blue cord, so that it will be on the skillfully woven band of the ephod, and that the breastpiece will not come loose from the ephod. (29) "Aaron shall carry the names of the sons of Israel in the breastpiece of judgment over his heart when he enters the holy place, for a memorial before the LORD continually.

Exodus 28:36-37 NASB "You shall also make a plate of pure gold and shall engrave on it, like the engravings of a seal, 'Holy to the LORD.' (37) "You shall fasten it on a blue cord, and it shall be on the turban; it shall be at the front of the turban.

Exodus 29 Shows Aaron anointed, Bull slaughtered, then Aaron's sons anointed

Type & shadow of Christ anointed, slaughtered then the body of Christ anointed

Exodus 28:31-32 NASB "You shall make the robe of the ephod all of blue.
(32) "There shall be an opening at its top in the middle of it; around its opening there shall be a binding of woven work, like the opening of a coat of mail, so that it will not be torn.

Leviticus 21:10 NASB "The priest who is the highest among his brothers, on whose head the anointing oil has been poured and who has been consecrated to wear the garments, shall not uncover his head nor tear his clothes;

Matthew 26:62-65 NASB

(62) The high priest stood up and said to Him, "Do You not answer? What is it that these men are testifying against You?"

(63) But Jesus kept silent. And the high priest said to Him, "I adjure You by the living God, that You tell us whether You are the Christ, the Son of God."

(64) Jesus *said to him, "**You have said it *yourself*; nevertheless I tell you, hereafter you will see THE SON OF MAN SITTING AT THE RIGHT HAND OF POWER, and COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN.**"

(65) Then the high priest tore his robes and said, "He has blasphemed! What further need do we have of witnesses? Behold, you have now heard the blasphemy;

John 19:23-24 NASB

(23) Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His outer garments and made four parts, a part to every soldier and *also* the tunic; now the tunic was seamless, woven in one piece.

(24) So they said to one another, "Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it, *to decide* whose it shall be"; *this was* to fulfill the Scripture: "THEY DIVIDED MY OUTER GARMENTS AMONG THEM, AND FOR MY CLOTHING THEY CAST LOTS."

Isaiah 51:22 NLT This is what the Sovereign LORD, your God and Defender, says: "See, I have taken the terrible cup from your hands. You will drink no more of My fury.

Isaiah 54:8-10 NLT

- (8) In a burst of anger I turned My face away for a little while. But with everlasting love I will have compassion on you," says the LORD, your Redeemer.
- (9) "Just as I swore in the time of Noah that I would never again let a flood cover the earth, so now I swear that I will never again be angry and punish you.
- (10) For the mountains may move and the hills disappear, but even then My faithful love for you will remain. My covenant of blessing will never be broken," says the LORD, who has mercy on you.

Luke 8:43-48 NASB And a woman who had a hemorrhage for twelve years, and could not be healed by anyone, (44) came up behind Him and touched the fringe of His cloak, and immediately her hemorrhage stopped. (45) And Jesus said, "**Who is the one who touched Me?**" And while they were all denying it, Peter said, "Master, the people are crowding and pressing in on You." (46) But Jesus said, "**Someone did touch Me, for I was aware that power had gone out of Me.**" (47) When the woman saw that she had not escaped notice, she came trembling and fell down before Him, and declared in the presence of all the people the reason why she had touched Him, and how she had been immediately healed. (48) And He said to her, "**Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace.**"

Malachi 4:2 NLT "But for you who fear My name, the Sun of Righteousness will rise **with healing in His wings** [*corner, fringe*]. And you will go free, leaping with joy like calves let out to pasture.

Hebrew: tēkêleth: blue(violet)

Hebrew root: kâlâh: to be complete

John 19:30 NASB Therefore when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "**It is finished!**" [*Greek: teleō, Hebrew: kâlâh*] And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.
