Message Today: What Can You See?

Genesis 13:1-18 NLT So Abram left Egypt and traveled north into the Negev, along with his wife and Lot and all that they owned. (2) (Abram was very rich in livestock, silver, and gold.) (3) From the Negev, they continued traveling by stages toward Bethel, and they pitched their tents between Bethel and Ai, where they had camped before. (4) This was the same place where Abram had built the altar, and there he worshiped the LORD again. (5) Lot, who was traveling with Abram, had also become very wealthy with flocks of sheep and goats, herds of cattle, and many tents. (6) But the land could not support both Abram and Lot with all their flocks and herds living so close together. (7) So disputes broke out between the herdsmen of Abram and Lot. (At that time Canaanites and Perizzites were also living in the land.) (8) Finally Abram said to Lot, "Let's not allow this conflict to come between us or our herdsmen. After all, we are close relatives! (9) The whole countryside is open to you. Take your choice of any section of the land you want, and we will separate. If you want the land to the left, then I'll take the land on the right. If you prefer the land on the right, then I'll go to the left." (10) Lot took a long look at the fertile plains of the Jordan Valley in the direction of Zoar. The whole area was well watered everywhere, like the garden of the LORD or the beautiful land of Egypt. (This was before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah.) (11) Lot chose for himself the whole Jordan Valley to the east of them. He went there with his flocks and servants and parted company with his uncle Abram. (12) So Abram settled in the land of Canaan, and Lot moved his tents to a place near Sodom and settled among the cities of the plain. (13) But the people of this area were extremely wicked and constantly sinned against the LORD. (14) After Lot had gone, the LORD said to Abram, "**Look as far as you can see in every direction**—north and south, east and west. (15) I am giving all this land, **as far as you can see**, to you and your descendants as a permanent possession. (16) And I will give you so many descendants that, like the dust of the earth, they cannot be counted! (17) **Go and walk through the land in every direction**, for I am giving it to you." (18) So Abram moved his camp to Hebron and settled near the oak grove belonging to Mamre. There he built another altar to the LORD.

The question really is: "How do you really see God?"

God is love. We are to accept Him as the best love we can imagine with childlike faith!

We are to ALWAYS be looking through eyes of GREAT FAITH, seeing everything that God desires us to see with heavenly 20/20 vision so that we will be blessed with everything that God wants us to possess!

How much is that? As far as you can see :)

Hebrews 11:3 NASB By faith we understand that the worlds were prepared by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things which are visible.

see Genesis verse 13:14...

Ephesians 3:14-21 NASB For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, (15) from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name, (16) that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man, (17) so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; *and* that you, being rooted and grounded in love, (18) may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, (19) and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God. (20) Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, (21) to Him *be* the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.

Joshua 1:7-8 NASB "Only be strong and very courageous; be careful to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, so that you may have success wherever you go. (8) "This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success.

see Genesis verse 13:17...

Joshua 1:2-6 NASB "Moses My servant is dead; now therefore arise, cross

this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them, to the sons of Israel. (3) "Every place on which the sole of your foot treads, I have given it to you, just as I spoke to Moses. (4) "From the wilderness and this Lebanon, even as far as the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and as far as the Great Sea toward the setting of the sun will be your territory. (5) "No man will *be able to* stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I have been with Moses, I will be with you; I will not fail you or forsake you. (6) "Be strong and courageous, for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them.
