Why must we increase?

1. The Father's heart desires it - He desires *'MUCH FRUIT'*
2. The Kingdom of God must advance
3. Those around us need our overflow & discipleship
4. God desires increase for us

2 Corinthians 9:8-12 NASB

- (8) And God is able to make **all grace abound to you**, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance **for every good deed**;
- (9) as it is written, "HE SCATTERED ABROAD, HE GAVE TO THE POOR, HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS ENDURES FOREVER."
- (10) Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will **supply and multiply your seed for sowing** and **increase the harvest of**

your righteousness;

- (11) you will be enriched in everything for all liberality, which **through us is producing thanksgiving to God.**
- (12) For the ministry of this service is not only **fully supplying the needs of the saints, but is also overflowing through many thanksgivings** to God.

What we are outlining here are AREAS that we as Christians should take some responsibility for & intentionally press into expecting God to help us increase.

3 John 1:2 NASB Beloved, I pray that in **all respects you may prosper** [*in your hand*] and **be in good health** [*outer physical man*], just as **your soul prospers** [*inner spiritual man*].

Areas of increase:

Inner man, outer man & in our hands - EVERY PROMISE of God

- **In our hands:** resources: time, money, help, etc
 - **Philippians 4:19 NASB** And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
 - **Psalms 23:1-2 NASB A Psalm of David.** The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not want. (2) He makes me lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside quiet waters.
 - **Matthew 6:33 NASB** "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you."
- **Outer man:** health, strength, wisdom & knowledge, peace, full salvation- deliverance, restoration, protection, provision, health, preserved, saved
 - **Colossians 1:9-14 NASB**

(9) For this reason also, since the day we heard *of it*, we have not ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding,

(10) so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please *Him* in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

(11) strengthened with all power, according to His glorious might, for the attaining of all steadfastness and patience; joyously

(12) giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in

the inheritance of the saints in Light.

(13) For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,

(14) in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

- **Isaiah 12:2 NASB** "Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; For the LORD GOD is my strength and song, And He has become my salvation."

to SAVE: sōzō sode'-zo (Greek 4982) σωζω

* to save, that is, deliver or protect :

- heal, preserve, save, do well, be or make whole.

He has delivered you!

He has protected you!

He has saved you!

He has healed you!

He has preserved you!

He has made you to do well or prosper!

He has made you whole or restored!

- **Inner Man:** relationship & fellowship with God, eternal salvation, love, faith, hope & the fruit of the Spirit- love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control
 - **Matthew 1:23 NASB** "BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALL BE WITH CHILD AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND THEY SHALL CALL HIS NAME IMMANUEL," which translated means, "GOD WITH US."
 - **2 Corinthians 5:18 NASB (18)** Now all *these* things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation,
 - **1 Corinthians 13:13 NASB (13)** But now faith, hope, love, abide these three; but the greatest of these is love.
 - **Galatians 5:22-25 NASB** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy,

peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, (23)
gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. (24)
Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh
with its passions and desires. (25) If we live by the Spirit, let us
also walk by the Spirit.

**We must purpose ourselves to increase.
The world & our flesh will press us into areas that naturally
decrease us.**

We can't increase by ourselves.
