

Genesis 1:1-6 NLT In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. (2) The earth was formless and empty, and darkness covered the deep waters. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters. (3) Then God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. (4) And God saw that the light was good. Then He separated the light from the darkness. (5) God called the light "day" and the darkness "night." And evening passed and morning came, marking the first day. (6) Then God said, "Let there be a space between the waters, to separate the waters of the heavens from the waters of the earth."

Genesis 1:9 NLT Then God said, "Let the waters beneath the sky flow together into one place, so dry ground may appear." And that is what happened.

Genesis 1:11 NLT Then God said, "Let the land sprout with vegetation—every sort of seed-bearing plant, and trees that grow seed-bearing fruit. These seeds will then produce the kinds of plants and trees from which they came." And that is what happened.

Genesis 1:14 NLT Then God said, "Let lights appear in the sky to separate the day from the night. Let them be signs to mark the seasons, days, and years.

Genesis 1:20 NLT Then God said, "Let the waters swarm with fish and other life. Let the skies be filled with birds of every kind."

Genesis 1:24 NLT Then God said, "Let the earth produce every sort of animal, each producing offspring of the same kind—livestock, small animals that scurry along the ground, and wild animals." And that is what happened.

Genesis 1:26 NLT Then God said, "Let Us make human beings in Our image, to be like Us. They will reign over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, the livestock, all the wild animals on the earth, and the small animals that scurry along the ground."

Genesis 1:31 NLT Then God looked over all He had made, and He saw that it was very good! And evening passed and morning came, marking the sixth day.

Genesis 2:1-3 NLT So the creation of the heavens and the earth and everything in them was completed. (2) On the seventh day God had finished His work of creation, so He rested from all His work. (3) And God blessed the seventh day and declared it holy, because it was the day when He rested from all His work of creation.

God RESTED because His work was FINISHED.

Jesus then came ON BEHALF OF MANKIND & completed the work we needed to do!

John 19:30 NLT When Jesus had tasted it, **He said**, "It is finished!" Then He bowed His head and released His spirit.

We now LIVE in a sabbath REST because the work has been finished!

The body of Christ has a FULL REST available if they will take it through Jesus!

Hebrews 4:1-2 NLT God's promise of entering His rest still stands, so we ought to tremble with fear that some of you might fail to experience it. (2) For this good news—that God has prepared this rest—has been announced to us just as it was to them. But it did them no good because they didn't share the faith of those who listened to God.

How did they miss their rest?

Numbers 13:1-2 NLT The LORD now said to Moses, (2) "Send out men to explore the land of Canaan, the land I am giving to the Israelites. Send one leader from each of the twelve ancestral tribes."

Numbers 13:23 NLT When they came to the valley of Eshcol, they cut down a branch with a single cluster of grapes so large that it took two of them to

carry it on a pole between them! They also brought back samples of the pomegranates and figs.

Numbers 13:25-28 NLT After exploring the land for forty days, the men returned (26) to Moses, Aaron, and the whole community of Israel at Kadesh in the wilderness of Paran. They reported to the whole community what they had seen and showed them the fruit they had taken from the land. (27) This was their report to Moses: "We entered the land you sent us to explore, and it is indeed a bountiful country—a land flowing with milk and honey. Here is the kind of fruit it produces. (28) But the people living there are powerful, and their towns are large and fortified. We even saw giants there, the descendants of Anak!

Numbers 13:30-33 NLT But Caleb tried to quiet the people as they stood before Moses. "Let's go at once to take the land," he said. "We can certainly conquer it!" (31) But the other men who had explored the land with him disagreed. "We can't go up against them! They are stronger than we are!" (32) So they spread this bad report about the land among the Israelites: "The land we traveled through and explored will devour anyone who goes to live there. All the people we saw were huge. (33) We even saw giants there, the descendants of Anak. Next to them we felt like grasshoppers, and that's what they thought, too!"

Numbers 14:1-11 NLT Then the whole community began weeping aloud, and they cried all night. (2) Their voices rose in a great chorus of protest against Moses and Aaron. "If only we had died in Egypt, or even here in the wilderness!" they complained. (3) "Why is the LORD taking us to this country only to have us die in battle? Our wives and our little ones will be carried off as plunder! Wouldn't it be better for us to return to Egypt?" (4) Then they plotted among themselves, "Let's choose a new leader and go back to Egypt!" (5) Then Moses and Aaron fell face down on the ground before the whole community of Israel. (6) Two of the men who had explored the land, Joshua son of Nun and Caleb son of Jephunneh, tore their clothing. (7) They said to all the people of Israel, "The land we traveled through and explored is a wonderful land! (8) And if the LORD is pleased with us, He will bring us safely into that land and give it to us. It is a rich land flowing with milk and honey. (9) Do not rebel against the LORD, and don't be afraid of the people of the land. They are only helpless prey to us! They have no protection, but the LORD is with us! Don't be afraid of

them!" (10) But the whole community began to talk about stoning Joshua and Caleb. Then the glorious presence of the LORD appeared to all the Israelites at the Tabernacle. (11) And the LORD said to Moses, "How long will these people treat Me with contempt? Will they never believe Me, even after all the miraculous signs I have done among them?"

Numbers 14:20-24 NLT Then the LORD said, "I will pardon them as you have requested. (21) But as surely as I live, and as surely as the earth is filled with the LORD's glory, (22) not one of these people will ever enter that land. They have all seen My glorious presence and the miraculous signs I performed both in Egypt and in the wilderness, but again and again they have tested Me by refusing to listen to My voice. (23) They will never even see the land I swore to give their ancestors. None of those who have treated Me with contempt will ever see it. (24) But My servant Caleb has a different attitude than the others have. He has remained loyal to Me, so I will bring him into the land he explored. His descendants will possess their full share of that land.

Numbers 14:26-31 NLT Then the LORD said to Moses and Aaron, (27) "How long must I put up with this wicked community and its complaints about Me? Yes, I have heard the complaints the Israelites are making against Me. (28) Now tell them this: 'As surely as I live, declares the LORD, I will do to you the very things I heard you say. (29) You will all drop dead in this wilderness! Because you complained against Me, every one of you who is twenty years old or older and was included in the registration will die. (30) You will not enter and occupy the land I swore to give you. The only exceptions will be Caleb son of Jephunneh and Joshua son of Nun. (31) "You said your children would be carried off as plunder. Well, I will bring them safely into the land, and they will enjoy what you have despised.

How To Enter Your REST Today:

Hebrews 4:6-11 NLT So God's rest is there for people to enter, but those who first heard this good news failed to enter because they disobeyed God. (7) So God set another time for entering His rest, and that time is today. God announced this through David much later in the words already quoted: "Today when you hear His voice, don't harden your hearts." (8) Now if Joshua had succeeded in giving them this rest, God would not have spoken about another day of rest still to come. (9) So there is a special rest still waiting for the people of God. (10) For all who have entered into God's rest

have rested from their labors, just as God did after creating the world. (11)
So let us do our best to enter that rest. But if we disobey God, as the people
of Israel did, we will fall.
