Isaiah 5:13 KJV Therefore my people are gone into captivity, because *they have* no knowledge: ...

Hosea 4:6 NLT My people are being destroyed because they don't know Me...

Matthew 15:32-38 NASB (36) and He took the seven loaves and the fish; and giving thanks, He broke them and **started** giving them to the disciples, and the disciples *gave them* to the people.

- You are the body of Christ, the body of His anointing!
- The Church Is The Authority of Christ on the Earth

What Should Services Look Like?

Main Ingredients for a Church Gathering:

- Designed for Believers *(remember the church is made up of citizens, ekklesia)*
- All PLACED members of that body come
- All come with Thanksgiving & Praise
- All come with helping others on their mind
- All come to be trained & equipped for ministry
- All come intent on unity in Christ

1 Corinthians 12:18 NASB (18) But now God has placed the members, each one of them, in the body, just as He desired.

Psalms 100:4 NASB Enter His gates with **thanksgiving** *And* His courts with **praise**. Give thanks to Him, bless His name.

Galatians 6:2 NASB Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ.

Galatians 6:2 NLT Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ.

1 Corinthians 14:12 NASB (12) So also you, since you are zealous of spiritual *gifts,* seek to abound for the edification of the church.

Hebrews 10:24-25 NASB and let us consider how **to stimulate one another to love and good deeds**, (25) not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging *one another*; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.

Ephesians 4:11-13 NASB

- (11) And He gave some *as* apostles, and some *as* prophets, and some *as* evangelists, and some *as* pastors and teachers,
- (12) for the **equipping of the saints for the work of service**, to the **building up of the body** of Christ;
- (13) until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.

It's Training/Discipleship Center NOT a Salvation Center ONLY

Acts 1:14 NASB These **all with one mind** were continually devoting themselves to prayer, along with *the* women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.

Main Ingredients for a Church Service:

- Thanksgiving & Praise
- Unity
- Prayer

- Fellowship
- Words of encouragement, edification
- Manifestations of the Holy Spirit
- Full participation
- Training, equipping & impartation
- Godly order

Psalms 100:4 NASB Enter His gates with **thanksgiving** *And* His courts with **praise**. Give thanks to Him, bless His name.

Acts 1:14 NASB These all with one mind were continually devoting themselves to prayer, along with *the* women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.

Acts 2:42 NASB They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

1 Corinthians 14:26 NASB (26) What is *the outcome* then, brethren? When you assemble, each one has a psalm, has a teaching, has a revelation, has a tongue, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.

1 Corinthians 12:7 NASB (7) But **to each one** is given the manifestation of the Spirit **for the common good**.

Ephesians 4:11-13, 15-16 NASB And He gave some *as* apostles, and some *as* prophets, and some *as* evangelists, and some *as* pastors and teachers, (12) for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ; (13) until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.

(15) but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all *aspects* into Him who is the head, *even* Christ, (16) from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.

1 Corinthians 14:37-40 - Shows Participation & Order & Authority

How Does the Church Function?

First Mentions of The Church:

Acts 1:14 NASB These all with one mind were continually devoting themselves to prayer, along with *the* women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.

Acts 2:1 NASB When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place.

Acts 2:41-43 NASB So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and that day there were added about three thousand souls. (42) They were **continually devoting themselves** to the apostles' **teaching** and to **fellowship**, to the **breaking of bread and to prayer**. (43) Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and signs were taking place through the apostles.

They Were NOT Discouraged or Swayed From God's Will & Purpose

Acts 5:40-42 NASB They took his advice; and after calling the apostles in, they flogged them and ordered them not to speak in the name of Jesus, and *then* released them. (41) So they went on their way from the presence of the Council, rejoicing that they had been considered worthy to suffer shame for *His* name. (42) And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they kept right on teaching and preaching Jesus *as* the Christ.

Adding took place outside the church

Acts 5:12 NASB At the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were taking place among the people; and they were all with one accord in Solomon's portico.

The Angel's Message & Direction:

Acts 5:20 NASB "Go, stand and speak to the people in the temple[public place] the whole message [rhema] of this Life [zoe]."

The New Testament Church Prayer:

Acts 4:29-31 NASB "And now, Lord, take note of their threats, and grant that Your bond-servants may speak Your word with all confidence, (30) while You extend Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place

through the name of Your holy servant Jesus." (31) And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and *began* to speak the word of God with boldness.
