In today's environment, where do you go when you want to find something?

Matthew 6:33 NASB "**But seek first [desire & inquire about] His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.**

What is one of the first things that an enemy will do in a war between headquarters & the men in the field?

Seeking First is Humility:

1. I don't know everything
2. Lord I NEED You
3. Lord I love You

In EVERY thing that we do, we should ask these questions:

1. What does God want me to do?
2. Does this advance God's Kingdom?
3. How should it be done according to the way the Kingdom works?
4. What would be done in an absolute righteous way?

Genesis 4:1-7 NLT Now Adam had sexual relations with his wife, Eve, and she became pregnant. When she gave birth to Cain, she said, "With the LORD's help, I have produced a man!" (2) Later she gave birth to his brother and named him Abel. When they grew up, Abel became a shepherd, while Cain cultivated the ground. (3) When it was time for the harvest, Cain presented some of his crops as a gift to the LORD. (4) Abel also brought a gift—the best of the firstborn lambs from his flock. The LORD accepted Abel and his gift, (5) but He did not accept Cain and his gift. This made Cain very angry, and he looked dejected. (6) "Why are you so angry?" the LORD asked Cain. "Why do you look so dejected? (7) You will be accepted if you do what is right. But if you refuse to do what is right, then watch out! Sin is crouching at the door, eager to control you. But you must subdue it and be its master."

If we are seeking God first, we bring the best, not the leftovers.

Hebrews 11:4 NLT It was by faith that Abel brought a more acceptable offering to God than Cain did. Abel's offering gave evidence that he was a righteous man, and God showed His approval of his gifts. Although Abel is long dead, he still speaks to us by his example of faith.

Matthew 6:31-34 NASB

- (31) "Do not worry then, saying, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' or 'What will we wear for clothing?'"
- (32) "For the Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things."
- (33) "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you."
- (34) "So do not worry about tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own."

Matthew 6:31-34 MSG What I'm trying to do here is to get you to relax, to not be so preoccupied with getting, so you can respond to God's giving. (32) People who don't know God and the way he works fuss over these things, but you know both God and how he works. (33) Steep your life in God-reality, God-initiative, God-provisions. Don't worry about missing out. You'll find all your everyday human concerns will be met. (34) "Give your entire attention to what God is doing right now, and don't get worked up about what may or may not happen tomorrow. God will help you deal with whatever hard things come up when the time comes."
