

**Matthew 16:15-19 NASB** He \*said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" (16) Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." (17) And Jesus said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Barjona, because flesh and blood did not reveal *this* to you, but My Father who is in heaven. (18) "I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it. (19) "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven."

## Acts 2 Peter's Sermon & Results John 18 Peter cuts off Malchus' ear

**Revelation 3:15-16 NASB** (15) 'I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot. (16) 'So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth.

**Luke 5:3-9 NASB** And He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little way from the land. And He sat down and *began* teaching the people from the boat. (4) When He had finished speaking, He said to Simon, "Put out into the deep water and let down your nets for a catch." (5) Simon answered and said, "Master, we worked hard all night and caught nothing, but I will do as You say *and* let down the nets." (6) When they had done this, they enclosed a great quantity of fish, and their nets *began* to break; (7) so they signaled to their partners in the other boat for them to come and help them. And they came and filled both of the boats, so that they began to sink. (8) But when Simon Peter saw *that*, he fell down at Jesus' feet, saying, "Go away from me Lord, for I am a sinful man!" (9) For amazement had seized him and all his companions because of the catch of fish which they had taken;

**John 21:3-8 NASB** Simon Peter \*said to them, "I am going fishing." They \*said to him, "We will also come with you." They went out and got into the

boat; and that night they caught nothing. (4) But when the day was now breaking, Jesus stood on the beach; yet the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. (5) So Jesus \*said to them, "Children, you do not have any fish, do you?" They answered Him, "No." (6) And He said to them, "Cast the net on the right-hand side of the boat and you will find a catch." So they cast, and then they were not able to haul it in because of the great number of fish. (7) Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved \*said to Peter, "It is the Lord." So when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put his outer garment on (for he was stripped *for work*), and threw himself into the sea. (8) But the other disciples came in the little boat, for they were not far from the land, but about one hundred yards away, dragging the net *full* of fish.

**John 13:3-10 NASB** *Jesus*, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come forth from God and was going back to God, (4) \*got up from supper, and \*laid aside His garments; and taking a towel, He girded Himself. (5) Then He \*poured water into the basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded. (6) So He \*came to Simon Peter. He \*said to Him, "Lord, do You wash my feet?" (7) Jesus answered and said to him, "What I do you do not realize now, but you will understand hereafter." (8) Peter \*said to Him, "Never shall You wash my feet!" Jesus answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me." (9) Simon Peter \*said to Him, "Lord, *then wash* not only my feet, but also my hands and my head." (10) Jesus \*said to him, "He who has bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all *of you*."

**Peter: "You're not washing MY feet Lord."**

**Jesus: "You're wrong."**

**Peter: "Then I'll get ALL IN to get right!"**
