2 Timothy 1:7 KJV For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

2 Timothy 1:7 NASB For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline.

If you have fear or timidity or a lack of boldness, it is NOT from God. Don't put up with it! BE BOLD against that fear!

Areas to watch for timidity & fear:

- Witnessing
- Approaching God (Hebrews 4:16)
- Problems
- Health
- Finances
- Being Filled with the Spirit
- Operating in the gifts of the Spirit
- etc

Acts 4:13 NASB Now as they observed the confidence of Peter and John and understood that they were uneducated and untrained men, they were amazed, and *began* to recognize them as having been with Jesus.

Proverbs 28:1 NASB The wicked flee when no one is pursuing, But the righteous are bold as a lion.

Ephesians 3:11-12 NASB *This was* in accordance with the eternal purpose which He carried out in Christ Jesus our Lord, (12) in whom we have boldness and confident access through faith in Him.

2 Corinthians 3:12 NASB (12) Therefore having such a hope, we use great boldness in *our* speech,

Joshua 1:9 NASB "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

Acts 28:30-31 NLT For the next two years, Paul lived in Rome at his own expense. He welcomed all who visited him, (31) boldly proclaiming the Kingdom of God and teaching about the Lord Jesus Christ. And no one tried to stop him.

Romans 8:15 NASB For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"

How do I take the step into BOLDNESS?

2 Timothy 1:6-7 NASB For this reason I remind you to kindle afresh the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands. (7) For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline.

Jude 1:20 NASB But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit,

Ephesians 6:19-20 NASB and *pray* on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel, (20) for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in *proclaiming* it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

Acts 4:29-30 NASB "And now, Lord, take note of their threats, and grant that Your bond-servants may speak Your word with all confidence, (30) while You extend Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place through the name of Your holy servant Jesus."

God's Response WILL BE:

Acts 4:31-35 NASB And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and *began* to speak the word of God with boldness. (32) And the congregation of those who believed were of one heart and soul; and not one *of them* claimed that anything belonging to him was his own, but all things were common property to them. (33) And with great power the apostles

were giving testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and abundant grace was upon them all. (34) For there was not a needy person among them, for all who were owners of land or houses would sell them and bring the proceeds of the sales (35) and lay them at the apostles' feet, and they would be distributed to each as any had need.
