Colossians 3:23 NASB Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men,

Acts 9:1, 3-5 NASB Now Saul, still breathing threats and murder against the disciples of the Lord, went to the high priest,

- (3) As he was traveling, it happened that he was approaching Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him; (4) and he fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?" (5) And he said, "Who are You, Lord?" And He said, "I am Jesus whom you are persecuting,
- 1 Timothy 5:8 NASB But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.
- 1 Timothy 3:4-5 NASB *He must be* one who manages his own household well, keeping his children under control with all dignity (5) (but if a man does not know how to manage his own household, how will he take care of the church of God?),

Psalms 127:1-2 NASB Unless the LORD builds the house, They labor in vain who build it; Unless the LORD guards the city, The watchman keeps awake in vain. (2) It is vain for you to rise up early, To retire late, To eat the bread of painful labors; For He gives to His beloved *even in his* sleep.

Mark 11:12-14 NASB On the next day, when they had left Bethany, He became hungry. (13) Seeing at a distance a fig tree in leaf, He went *to see* if perhaps He would find anything on it; and when He came to it, He found nothing but leaves, for it was not the season for figs. (14) He said to it, "May no one ever eat fruit from you again!" And His disciples were listening.
