

Acts 8:5-24

1 Corinthians 2:4-5 NASB

- (4) and my message and my preaching were not in persuasive words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power,
- (5) so that your faith would not rest on the wisdom of men, but on the power of God.
- 1 Corinthians 2:4 GNB and my teaching and message were not delivered with skillful words of human wisdom, but with convincing proof of the power of God's Spirit.

2 Timothy 3:1-5 NASB

- (1) But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come.
- (2) For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy,
- (3) unloving, irreconcilable, malicious gossips, without self-control, brutal, haters of good,
- (4) treacherous, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God,
- (5) holding to a form of godliness, although they have denied its power; Avoid such men as these.

Isaiah 60:1-3 NASB

- (1) "Arise, shine; for your light has come, And the glory of the LORD has risen upon you.
- (2) "For behold, darkness will cover the earth And deep darkness the peoples; But the LORD will rise upon you And His glory will appear upon you.
- (3) "Nations will come to your light, And kings to the brightness of your rising.

Acts 1:4-8 NASB

- (4) Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, "Which," He said, "you heard of from Me;
- (5) for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."
- (6) So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, "Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?"
- (7) He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority;
- (8) but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

Acts 2:1-4 NASB

- (1) When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place.
- (2) And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.
- (3) And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they rested on each one of them.
- (4) And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance.
