Matthew 12:36 NASB "But I tell you that every careless [KJV- idle] word that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment.

Careless/Idle: inactive, unemployed, lazy, useless, barren, unproductive

Matthew 12:34-37 MSG

- (34) "You have minds like a snake pit! How do you suppose what you say is worth anything when you are so foul-minded? It's your heart, not the dictionary, that gives meaning to your words.
- (35) A good person produces good deeds and words season after season. An evil person is a blight on the orchard.
- (36) Let me tell you something: Every one of these careless words is going to come back to haunt you. There will be a time of Reckoning. Words are powerful; take them seriously.
- (37) Words can be your salvation. Words can also be your damnation."

James 1:26 NASB If anyone thinks himself to be religious, and yet does not bridle his tongue but deceives his *own* heart, this man's religion is worthless.

James 3:1-13 NASB

- (1) Let not many *of you* become teachers, my brethren, knowing that as such we will incur a stricter judgment.
- (2) For we all stumble in many *ways*. If anyone does not stumble in what he says, he is a perfect man, able to bridle the whole body as well.
- (3) Now if we put the bits into the horses' mouths so that they will obey us, we direct their entire body as well.
- (4) Look at the ships also, though they are so great and are driven by strong winds, are still directed by a very small rudder wherever the inclination of the pilot desires.
- (5) So also the tongue is a small part of the body, and *yet* it boasts of great things. See how great a forest is set aflame by such a small fire!
- (6) And the tongue is a fire, the *very* world of iniquity; the tongue is set

among our members as that which defiles the entire body, and sets on fire the course of *our* life, and is set on fire by hell.

- (7) For every species of beasts and birds, of reptiles and creatures of the sea, is tamed and has been tamed by the human race.
- (8) But no one can tame the tongue; *it is* a restless evil *and* full of deadly poison.
- (9) With it we bless *our* Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the likeness of God;
- (10) from the same mouth come *both* blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be this way.
- (11) Does a fountain send out from the same opening *both* fresh and bitter *water*?
- (12) Can a fig tree, my brethren, produce olives, or a vine produce figs? Nor *can* salt water produce fresh.
- (13) Who among you is wise and understanding? Let him show by his good behavior his deeds in the gentleness of wisdom.
