A Mess Up...& An Answer

Numbers 21:5-9 NLT and they began to speak against God and Moses.

"Why have you brought us out of Egypt to die here in the wilderness?" they complained. "There is nothing to eat here and nothing to drink. And we hate this horrible manna!" (6) So the LORD sent poisonous snakes among the people, and many were bitten and died. (7) Then the people came to Moses and cried out, "We have sinned by speaking against the LORD and against you. Pray that the LORD will take away the snakes." So Moses prayed for the people. (8) Then the LORD told him, "Make a replica of a poisonous snake and attach it to a pole. All who are bitten will live if they simply look at it!" (9) So Moses made a snake out of bronze and attached it to a pole. Then anyone who was bitten by a snake could look at the bronze snake and be healed!

A Mess Up...& An Answer

John 3:14-21 NLT

- (14) **And as Moses lifted up the bronze snake on a pole in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up,**
- (15) **so that everyone who believes in Him will have eternal life.**
- (16) **"For God loved the world so much that He gave His one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life.**
- (17) **God sent His Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through Him.**
- (18) **"There is no judgment against anyone who believes in Him. But anyone who does not believe in Him has already been judged for not believing in God's one and only Son.**
- (19) **And the judgment is based on this fact: God's light came into the world, but people loved the darkness more than the light, for their actions were evil.**
- (20) **All who do evil hate the light and refuse to go near it for fear their sins will be exposed.**
- (21) **But those who do what is right come to the light so others can see that they are doing what God wants. "**

Are there Bad Realities?

Matthew 25:41 NLT "Then the King will turn to those on the left and say, 'Away with you, you cursed ones, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his demons.'

Does God WANT Bad Things To Happen To People?

1 Timothy 2:3-6 NASB This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, (4) who **desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.** (5) For there is one God, *and* one mediator also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus, (6) who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony *given* at the proper time.

How Much Does He Love Us?

Romans 5:6 NASB For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.

Romans 5:8 NASB But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 5:10 NASB For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

Philippians 2:5-8 NASB Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, (6) who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, (7) but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men. (8) Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

2 Peter 3:9 NASB The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance.

Jesus Has Given You The Path To An Answer!

2 Corinthians 5:17-21 NLT (17) This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! (18) And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to Himself

through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to Him. (19) For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to Himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And He gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. (20) So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making His appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" (21) For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.
