Daniel 11:32 KJV ...but the people that do know their God shall be **strong**, and do *exploits*.

Joshua 1:3 NASB "**Every place** on which the sole of your foot treads, I have given it to you, just as I spoke to Moses.

Joshua 1:5-6 NASB "No man will be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I have been with Moses, I will be with you; I will not fail you or forsake you. (6) "Be strong and courageous, for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them.

Exodus 5:1-2 NASB And afterward Moses and Aaron came and said to Pharaoh, "Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, 'Let My people go that they may celebrate a feast to Me in the wilderness.'" (2) But Pharaoh said, "Who is the LORD that I should obey His voice to let Israel go? I do not know the LORD, and besides, I will not let Israel go."

Exodus 5:7-9 NASB "You are no longer to give the people straw to make brick as previously; let them go and gather straw for themselves. (8) "But the quota of bricks which they were making previously, you shall impose on them; you are not to reduce any of it. Because they are lazy, therefore they cry out, 'Let us go and sacrifice to our God.' (9) "Let the labor **be heavier** on the men, and let them work at it **so that they will pay no attention to false words**."

Mark 4:17 NASB and they have no *firm* root in themselves, but are *only* temporary; then, when affliction or persecution arises because of the word, immediately they fall away.

Exodus 5:21-23 NASB They said to them, "May the LORD look upon you and judge *you*, for you have made us odious in Pharaoh's sight and in the sight of his servants, to put a sword in their hand to kill us." (22) Then

Moses returned to the LORD and said, "O Lord, why have You brought harm to this people? Why did You ever send me? (23) "Ever since I came to Pharaoh to speak in Your name, he has done harm to this people, and You have not delivered Your people at all."

Exodus 6:1 NASB Then the LORD said to Moses, "Now you shall see what I will do to Pharaoh; for under compulsion he will let them go, and under compulsion he will drive them out of his land."

## Exodus 6:6-9 NASB

- (6) "Say, therefore, to the sons of Israel, 'I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will deliver you from their bondage. I will also redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.
- (7) 'Then I will take you for My people, and I will be your God; and you shall know that I am the LORD your God, who brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- (8) 'I will bring you to the land which I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and I will give it to you *for* a possession; I am the LORD.'"
- (9) So Moses spoke thus to the sons of Israel, but they did not listen to Moses on account of *their* despondency *[impatience, anguish & shortness of spirit]* and cruel bondage.

## **EXAMPLE: Bootcamp hurt knee & going home**

Acts 4:1-4 NASB As they were speaking to the people, the priests and the captain of the temple *guard* and the Sadducees came up to them, (2) being greatly disturbed because they were teaching the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection from the dead. (3) And they laid hands on them and put them in jail until the next day, for it was already evening. (4) But many of those who had heard the message believed; and the number of the men came to be about five thousand.

Acts 4:13 NASB Now as they observed **the confidence** of Peter and John and understood that they were uneducated and untrained men, they were amazed, and *began* to recognize them as having been with Jesus.

Acts 4:16-20 NASB saying, "What shall we do with these men? For the fact that a noteworthy miracle has taken place through them is apparent to all

who live in Jerusalem, and we cannot deny it. (17) "But so that it will not spread any further among the people, let us warn them to speak no longer to any man in this name." (18) And when they had summoned them, they commanded them not to speak or teach at all in the name of Jesus. (19) But Peter and John answered and said to them, "Whether it is right in the sight of God to give heed to you rather than to God, you be the judge; (20) for we cannot stop speaking about what we have seen and heard."

Acts 4:29-31 NASB "And now, Lord, take note of their threats, and grant that Your bond-servants may speak Your word with all confidence, (30) while You extend Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place through the name of Your holy servant Jesus." (31) And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and *began* to speak the word of God with **boldness**.
