

Message Today: **He's Still The SAME!**

Hebrews 13:8 NASB Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday and today and forever.

- Romans 5:6 NASB For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.
- Romans 5:8 NASB But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
- Romans 5:10 NASB For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

SAME Heart!

Philippians 2:5-7 NLT You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. (6) Though He was God, He did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. (7) Instead, He gave up His divine privileges; He took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When He appeared in human form,

SAME Mercy & Forgiveness!

John 8:3-4 NLT As He was speaking, the teachers of religious law and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in the act of adultery. They put her in front of the crowd. (4) "Teacher," they said to Jesus, "this woman was caught in the act of adultery.

John 8:10-11 NLT Then Jesus stood up again and said to the woman, "Where are your accusers? Didn't even one of them condemn you?" (11) "No, Lord," she said. And Jesus said, "Neither do I. Go and sin no more."

Mark 15:11-14 NLT But at this point the leading priests stirred up the crowd to demand the release of Barabbas instead of Jesus. (12) Pilate asked them, "Then what should I do with this man you call the king of the Jews?" (13) They shouted back, "Crucify Him!" (14) "Why?" Pilate demanded. "What crime has He committed?" But the mob roared even louder, "Crucify Him!"

Luke 23:34-37 NLT Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they don't know what they are doing." And the soldiers gambled for His clothes by throwing dice. (35) The crowd watched and the leaders scoffed. "He saved others," they said, "let Him save Himself if He is really God's Messiah, the Chosen One." (36) The soldiers

mocked Him, too, by offering Him a drink of sour wine. (37) They called out to Him, "If You are the King of the Jews, save Yourself!"

SAME Commitment!

Luke 22:42 NASB saying, "Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Yours be done."

Philippians 2:8 NLT He humbled Himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross.

SAME Power!

Matthew 28:2-4 NLT Suddenly there was a great earthquake! For an angel of the Lord came down from heaven, rolled aside the stone, and sat on it. (3) His face shone like lightning, and his clothing was as white as snow. (4) The guards shook with fear when they saw him, and they fell into a dead faint.

Luke 24:4-8 NLT As they stood there puzzled, two men suddenly appeared to them, clothed in dazzling robes. (5) The women were terrified and bowed with their faces to the ground. Then the men asked, "Why are you looking among the dead for someone who is alive? (6) He isn't here! He is risen from the dead! Remember what He told you back in Galilee, (7) that the Son of Man must be betrayed into the hands of sinful men and be crucified, and that He would rise again on the third day." (8) Then they remembered that He had said this.

Matthew 28:17-20 NLT When they saw Him, they worshiped Him—but some of them doubted! (18) Jesus came and told His disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. (19) Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. (20) Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Ephesians 1:18-21 NASB *I pray that* the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, (19) and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. *These are* in accordance with the working of the strength of His might (20) which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly *places*, (21) far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come.
