We Should Produce Lasting Fruit

John 15:16 NLT You didn't choose Me. I chose you. **I appointed you to go and produce lasting fruit**, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask for, using My name.

John 4:34-36 NLT (34) Then Jesus explained: "My nourishment comes from doing the will of God, who sent Me, and from finishing His work. (35) You know the saying, 'Four months between planting and harvest.' But I say, wake up and look around. The fields are already ripe for harvest. (36) The harvesters are paid good wages, and the **fruit they harvest is people** brought to eternal life. What joy awaits both the planter and the harvester alike!

We Are Called To Be on Fire for God!

Revelation 3:15-16 NASB (15) 'I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot. (16) 'So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth.

Are we going to be on fire doing it our way?

Our Fleshly Nature Always Has a Lack of Esteem for What We Have

2 Kings 4:1-7 NLT One day the widow of a member of the group of prophets came to Elisha and cried out, "My husband who served you is dead, and you know how he feared the LORD. But now a creditor has come, threatening to take my two sons as slaves." (2) "What can I do to help you?" Elisha asked. "Tell me, what do you have in the house?" "**Nothing at all, except a flask of olive oil,**" she replied. (3) And Elisha said, "Borrow as many empty jars as you can from your friends and neighbors. (4) Then go into your house with your sons and shut the door behind you. Pour olive oil from your flask into the jars, setting each one aside when it is filled." (5) So she did as she was told. Her sons kept bringing jars to her, and she filled one after another. (6) Soon every container was full to the brim! "Bring me another jar," she said to one of her sons. "There aren't any more!" he told her. And then the olive oil stopped flowing. (7) When she told the man of God what had happened, he said to her, "Now sell the olive oil and pay your debts, and you and your sons can live on what is left over."

John 6:2-11 NLT A huge crowd kept following Him wherever He went, because they saw His miraculous signs as He healed the sick. (3) Then Jesus climbed a hill and sat down with His disciples around Him. (4) (It was nearly time for the Jewish Passover celebration.) (5) Jesus soon saw a huge crowd of people coming to look for Him. Turning to Philip, He asked, "Where can we buy bread to feed all these people?" (6) He was testing Philip, for He already knew what He was going to do. (7) Philip replied, "Even if we worked for months, we wouldn't have enough money to feed them!" (8) Then Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up. (9) "There's a young boy here with five barley loaves and two fish. **But what good is that with this huge crowd?**" (10) "Tell everyone to sit down," Jesus said. So they all sat down on the grassy slopes. (The men alone numbered about 5,000.) (11) Then Jesus took the loaves, gave thanks to God, and distributed them to the people. Afterward He did the same with the fish. And they all ate as much as they wanted.

Jesus, takes what we have in our hand & makes it complete!

Philippians 4:19 NASB And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

The Discrepancy - Looking at what they didn't have

1 Corinthians 15:6 NASB (6) After that He appeared to more than **five hundred brethren** at one time, most of whom remain until now, but some have fallen asleep;

Acts 1:14-15 NASB These all with one mind were continually devoting themselves to prayer, along with *the* women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers. (15) At this time Peter stood up in the midst of the brethren (a gathering of **about one hundred and twenty** persons was there together), and said,

JESUS-

John 20:22 NASB And when He had said this, He breathed on them and *said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.

A COMMAND & A PROMISE-

Acts 1:1-8 NASB The first account I composed, Theophilus, about all that Jesus began to do and teach, (2) until the day when He was taken up *to heaven*, after He had by the Holy Spirit given orders to the apostles whom He had chosen. (3)

To these He also presented Himself alive after His suffering, by many convincing proofs, appearing to them over *a period of* forty days and speaking of the things concerning the kingdom of God. (4) Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, "Which," He said, "you heard of from Me; (5) for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now." (6) So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, "Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?" (7) He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority; (8) but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

What Happened?

Acts 2:1-4 NASB When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. (2) And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. (3) And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they rested on each one of them. (4) And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance.

Acts 2:41 NASB So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and that day there were added about three thousand souls.

John 3:16-17 NASB "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. (17) "For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.

Ephesians 5:18 NASB And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit,
