

Message Today: **What To Do When ALL HELL Breaks Loose! 2**

The TRUST of Abraham

Genesis 22:1-18 NASB Now it came about after these things, that God tested Abraham, and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." (2) He said, "Take now your son, your only son, whom you love, Isaac, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I will tell you." (3) So Abraham rose early in the morning and saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him and Isaac his son; and he split wood for the burnt offering, and arose and went to the place of which God had told him. (4) On the third day Abraham raised his eyes and saw the place from a distance. (5) Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey, and I and the lad will go over there; and we will worship and return to you." (6) Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering and laid it on Isaac his son, and he took in his hand the fire and the knife. So the two of them walked on together. (7) Isaac spoke to Abraham his father and said, "My father!" And he said, "Here I am, my son." And he said, "Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?" (8) Abraham said, "God will provide for Himself the lamb for the burnt offering, my son." So the two of them walked on together. (9) Then they came to the place of which God had told him; and Abraham built the altar there and arranged the wood, and bound his son Isaac and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood. (10) Abraham stretched out his hand and took the knife to slay his son. (11) But the angel of the LORD called to him from heaven and said, "Abraham, Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." (12) He said, "Do not stretch out your hand against the lad, and do nothing to him; for now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me." (13) Then Abraham raised his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him a ram caught in the thicket by his horns; and Abraham went and took the ram and offered him up for a burnt offering in the place of his son. (14) Abraham called the name of that place The LORD Will Provide, as it is said to this day, "In the mount of the LORD it will be provided." (15) Then the angel of the LORD called to Abraham a second time from heaven, (16) and said, "By Myself I have sworn, declares the LORD, because you have done this thing and have not withheld your son, your only son, (17) indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your seed shall possess the gate of their enemies. (18) "In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice."

Hebrews 11:17-19 NASB By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises was offering up his only begotten son; (18) it was he to whom it was said, "IN ISAAC YOUR DESCENDANTS SHALL BE CALLED." (19) He considered that God is able to raise people even from the dead, from which he also received him back as a type.

The TRUST of Jesus

Matthew 27:46 NASB About the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "ELI, ELI, LAMA SABACHTHANI?" that is, "MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?"

John 19:30 NASB Therefore when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.

Luke 23:46 NASB And Jesus, crying out with a loud voice, said, "Father, INTO YOUR HANDS I COMMIT MY SPIRIT." Having said this, He breathed His last.

Psalms 31:1-5 NASB In You, O LORD, I have taken refuge; Let me never be ashamed; In Your righteousness deliver me. (2) Incline Your ear to me, rescue me quickly; Be to me a rock of strength, A stronghold to save me. (3) For You are my rock and my fortress; For Your name's sake You will lead me and guide me. (4) You will pull me out of the net which they have secretly laid for me, For You are my strength. (5) **Into Your hand I commit my spirit;** You have ransomed me, O LORD, God of truth.

Spiritual Warfare (Jonathan Shuttlesworth):

1. **Know that the devil has NO power!** **Matthew 28:18 NASB** And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

*You must understand that the dominion of light over darkness is instant, unquestionable & sweatless! **The battle is OVER!***

2. **Pray to build yourself up**
3. **Know/Preach the Word**
4. **Bear Fruit** - manifest freedom: win souls, baptize in the Holy Ghost, make disciples, heal the sick, cast out demons, raise the dead, etc
