Fear Removes the Power From Our Life

- Peter walking on the water- [Matthew 14:25](#)
- Job- [Job 3:25 KJV](#) For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me.
- Disciples in the storm rebuked for fear
- To Jairus: Fear NOT! Only Believe

We MUST Get Revelation That:

- FEAR is our ENEMY!
- It is an ENEMY to the manifested POWER of God!
- FEAR is an ENEMY to GOD Himself!

[1 John 4:7-21 NASB](#) Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. (8) The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love. (9) By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him. (10) In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. (11) Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. (12) No one has seen God at any time; if we love one another, God abides in us, and His love is perfected in us. (13) By this we know that we abide in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit. (14) We have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son to be the Savior of the world. (15) Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God. (16) We have come to know and have believed the love which God has for us. God is love, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him. (17) By this, love is perfected with us, so that we may have confidence in the day of judgment; because as He is, so also are we in this world. (18) There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves punishment, and the one who fears is not perfected in love. (19) We love, because He first loved us. (20) If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. (21) And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother also.

Romans 8:1 NASB Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

Romans 8:14-15 NASB For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. (15) For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"

- God is the exact opposite of FEAR
- God is not located at the place of FEAR
- If we choose a road of FEAR, God is not located there

What To Do When Fear Tries To Come:

1- TRUST HIM

Jesus came to destroy fear!

Luke 1:73-75 NASB The oath which He swore to Abraham our father, (74) To grant us that we, being rescued from the hand of our enemies, Might serve Him without fear, (75) In holiness and righteousness before Him all our days.

Psalms 56:2-4 NASB My foes have trampled upon me all day long, For they are many who fight proudly against me. (3) When I am afraid, I will put my trust in You. (4) In God, whose word I praise, In God I have put my trust; I shall not be afraid. What can mere man do to me?

Psalms 55:22 NASB Cast your burden upon the LORD and He will sustain you; He will never allow the righteous to be shaken.

Psalms 37:5 NASB Commit your way to the LORD, Trust also in Him, and He will do it.

Hebrews 13:5-8 NASB Make sure that your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, "I WILL NEVER DESERT YOU, NOR WILL I EVER FORSAKE YOU," (6) so that we confidently say, "THE LORD IS MY HELPER, I WILL NOT BE AFRAID. WHAT WILL MAN DO TO ME?"

(7) Remember those who led you, who spoke the word of God to you; and considering the result of their conduct, imitate their faith. (8) Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

2- STRENGTHEN YOURSELF IN HIM

1 Samuel 30:6 NASB Moreover David was greatly distressed because the people spoke of stoning him, for all the people were embittered, each one because of his sons and his daughters. But David strengthened himself in the LORD his God.

2 Timothy 1:6-7 NASB For this reason I remind you to kindle afresh [*stir up*] the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands. (7) For God has not given us a spirit of timidity [*fear*], but of power and love and discipline.

3- HUMBLE YOURSELF TO HIS LOVE

1 Peter 5:5-6 NASB You younger men, likewise, be subject to your elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE. (6) Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time,

4- CAST YOUR CARES & ANXIETY ON HIM

1 Peter 5:7-10 NASB casting all your anxiety [*cares*] on Him, because He cares for you. (8) Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. (9) But resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world. (10) After you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen and establish you.

5- THINK ONLY ON THINGS WORTHY OF PRAISE

Philippians 4:4-9 NASB Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice! (5) Let your gentle spirit be known to all men. The Lord is near. (6) Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. (7) And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (8) Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good repute, if there is any excellence and

if anything worthy of praise, dwell on these things. (9) The things you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you.

6- PUT FEAR IN IT'S PLACE!

2 Corinthians 10:3-7 NASB (3) For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh, (4) for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. (5) We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ, (6) and we are ready to punish all disobedience, whenever your obedience is complete. (7) You are looking at things as they are outwardly. If anyone is confident in himself that he is Christ's, let him consider this again within himself, that just as he is Christ's, so also are we.
