Message Today: **When Does Faith Run?**

**Pro 3:1-12 (NASB)** My son, do not forget my teaching, But let your heart keep my commandments; **2** For length of days and years of life And peace they will add to you. **3** Do not let kindness and truth leave you; Bind them around your neck, Write them on the tablet of your heart. **4** So you will find favor and good repute In the sight of God and man. **5** Trust in the LORD with all your heart And do not lean on your own understanding. **6** In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He will make your paths straight. **7** Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and turn away from evil. **8** It will be healing to your body And refreshment to your bones. **9** Honor the LORD from your wealth And from the first of all your produce; **10** So your barns will be filled with plenty And your vats will overflow with new wine. **11** My son, do not reject the discipline of the LORD Or loathe His reproof, **12** For whom the LORD loves He reproveth, Even as a father *corrects* the son in whom he delights.

**Rev 12:11 (NASB)** "And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death.

**Job 1:20 (NASB)** Then Job arose and tore his robe and shaved his head, and he fell to the ground and worshiped.

**Mar 15:33-34 (NASB)** When the sixth hour came, darkness fell over the whole land until the ninth hour. **34** At the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, "ELOI, ELOI, LAMA SABACHTHANI?" which is translated, "MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?"

**Luk 23:46 (NASB)** And Jesus, crying out with a loud voice, said, "Father, INTO YOUR HANDS I COMMIT MY SPIRIT." Having said this, He breathed His last.

**Psa 31:1-5 (NASB) For the choir director. A Psalm of David.** In You, O LORD, I have taken refuge; Let me never be ashamed; In Your righteousness deliver me. **2** Incline Your ear to me, rescue me quickly; Be to me a rock of strength, A stronghold to save me. **3** For You are my rock and my fortress; For Your name's sake You will lead me and guide me. **4** You will pull me out of the net which they have secretly laid for me, For You are my strength. **5** Into Your hand I commit my spirit; You have ransomed me, O LORD, God of truth.
