WHY Do We Celebrate Mothers?

Ephesians 6:1-3 NASB

- (1) Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.
- (2) HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER (which is the first commandment with a promise),
- (3) SO THAT IT MAY BE WELL WITH YOU, AND THAT YOU MAY LIVE LONG ON THE EARTH.

We Honor BOTH Physical and Spiritual Mothers-

Titus 2:3-5 NLT

- (3) Similarly, teach the older women to live in a way that honors God. They must not slander others or be heavy drinkers. Instead, they should teach others what is good.
- (4) These older women must train the younger women to love their husbands and their children,
- (5) to live wisely and be pure, to work in their homes, to do good, and to be submissive to their husbands. Then they will not bring shame on the word of God.

Some of the Things a Good Mom Does:

A mother treasures & meditates on the Call of God & Words of God spoken over their children

Luk 2:18-20 NASB

- (18) And all who heard it wondered at the things which were told them by the shepherds.
- (19) But **Mary treasured all these things, pondering them in her heart.**
- (20) The shepherds went back, glorifying and praising God for all that they had heard and seen, just as had been told them.

Luk 2:51 NASB

- (51) And He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and He continued in subjection to them; and His mother **treasured all *these* things in her heart.**
- A mother encourages the anointing, and has faith in her children**

John 2:1-12 NASB

- (1) On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there;
- (2) and both Jesus and His disciples were invited to the wedding.
- (3) When the wine ran out, the mother of Jesus *said to Him, "They have no wine."
- (4) And Jesus *said to her, "**Woman, what does that have to do with us? My hour has not yet come.**"
- (5) His mother *said to the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it."
- (6) Now there were six stone waterpots set there for the Jewish custom of purification, containing twenty or thirty gallons each.
- (7) Jesus *said to them, "**Fill the waterpots with water.**" So they filled them up to the brim.
- (8) And He *said to them, "**Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter.**" So they took it *to him*.
- (9) When the headwaiter tasted the water which had become wine, and did not know where it came from (but the servants who had drawn the water knew), the headwaiter *called the bridegroom,
- (10) and *said to him, "Every man serves the good wine first, and when *the people* have drunk freely, *then he serves* the poorer *wine*; *but* you have kept the good wine until now."
- (11) This beginning of *His* signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory, and His disciples believed in Him.
- (12) After this He went down to Capernaum, He and His mother and *His* brothers and His disciples; and they stayed there a few days.

A mother must step down in the heart of their child for Christ to reign

Matthew 12:46-50 NASB

- (46) While He was still speaking to the crowds, behold, His mother and brothers were standing outside, seeking to speak to Him.
- (47) Someone said to Him, "Behold, Your mother and Your brothers are standing outside seeking to speak to You."
- (48) But Jesus answered the one who was telling Him and said, "**Who is My mother and who are My brothers?**"
- (49) And stretching out His hand toward His disciples, He said, "**Behold My mother and My brothers!**"
- (50) "**For whoever does the will of My Father who is in heaven, he is My brother and sister and mother.**"

Luk 14:26 NASB

(26) "If anyone comes to Me, and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be My disciple.

A mother is there to the end

Joh 19:25 NASB

(25) Therefore the soldiers did these things. But **standing by the cross** of Jesus were His mother, and His mother's sister, Mary the *wife* of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene.

A mother continues on in God's plan

Act 1:14 NASB

(14) These all **with one mind were continually devoting themselves to prayer**, along with *the* women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.
